Protection of personal data according to the LOPD, Woodjam (owned by SARL IXMOD, registered under number 453289365 in the commercial court of Béziers, France) in application of current legislation on the protection of personal data, informs that personal data collected through the forms of the website: name, surname, address, e-mail and telephone number, are included in the specific automated files of users of the services of www.woodjam.com

The purpose of the collection and automated processing of personal data is to maintain the business relationship and to carry out information, training, consultancy and other activities of Woodjam. These data will only be transferred to those entities that are necessary for the sole purpose of fulfilling the purpose set out above, for example, we will send your data to the carrier who will have to deliver your order. In no case will we transfer your data to external entities for marketing or advertising purposes.

Woodjam takes the necessary measures to guarantee the security, integrity and confidentiality of the data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data. The user may at any time exercise the rights of access, opposition, rectification and cancellation recognised in the aforementioned Regulation (EU). For what purpose will we treat your personal data?

At Woodjam, we will treat your personal data collected through the website www.woodjam.com for the following purposes:

1. In case of contracting the goods and services offered through Woodjam, to maintain the contractual relationship, as well as the management, administration, information, provision and improvement of the service.

2. Submission of requested information through the forms provided in Woodjam.

3. Send newsletters, as well as commercial communications of Woodjam promotions and/or advertising. We remind you that you can oppose the sending of commercial communications by any means and at any time, by sending an email to the address indicated above. The fields in these

registers are compulsory, and it is impossible to carry out the expressed purposes if these data are not provided.

How long will the personal data collected be kept?

The personal data provided will be kept as long as the commercial relationship is maintained or you do not request its suppression and during the period for which legal responsibilities could derive from the services provided.

Legitimation:

The treatment of your data is carried out with the following legal bases that legitimise it:

1. The request for information and/or the contracting of the services of www.woodjam.com, whose terms and conditions will be made available to you in any case, prior to any eventual contracting.

2. Free, specific, informed and unequivocal consent, insofar as we inform you by making this privacy policy available to you. After reading this privacy policy, if you agree, you can accept it by means of a declaration or a clear affirmative action, such as ticking a box provided for this purpose. If you do not provide us with your data or if you do so erroneously or incompletely, we will not be able to attend to your request, and it will be impossible to provide you with the information requested or to carry out the contracting of the services.

Intellectual property of the software
